

# Green Pig with a Helmet

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## Materials

Worsted Weight Yarn  
Vanna's Choice in Fern  
I love this yarn in Graymist  
I love this yarn in Black  
I love this yarn in White  
Size E crochet hook  
Polyfiberfill  
Large Eye Needle

Gauge is not important for this project unless you have purchased a kit. Using the right size hook is important to ensure you have enough yarn.

## Abbreviations

SC – Single Crochet  
HDC – Half Double Crochet  
DC- Double Crochet  
CH- Chain  
FO – Fasten Off  
SL ST – Slip Stitch  
INC – Make two Single Crochet in Same Stitch

DEC – Single Crochet two stitches together

BLO – Back Loops Only

*Note: Entire project is worked in the round. Use a stitch marker or a scrap piece of yarn to mark the beginning of each row. Then you don't have to count every row. Do not join unless instructed to.*

*Parentheses indicate a repeat. Repeat the stitches in the parentheses for the number of times indicated.*

*The bracketed number [ ] is the number of stitches at the end of each row.*

*I spread my increases out so there isn't a seam on the finished piece. If you do not like this method, you can do regular increases.*

## BODY

In Fern, CH 5

Oval increase

**Round 1:** Starting in 2<sup>nd</sup> Chain from hook, 3 SC, 3 SC in last stitch, using the unused loops from the 1<sup>st</sup> three stitches,

3 SC, 3 SC in chain from first stitch [12].

**Round 2:** 3 SC, (INC) 3 times, 3 SC, (INC) 3 times [18].

**Round 3:** 3 SC, (SC, INC) 3 times, 3 SC, (SC, INC) 3 times [24].

**Round 4:** 3 SC, (SC, INC, SC) 3 times, 3 SC, (SC, INC, SC) 3 times [30].

**Round 5:** 3 SC, (3 SC, INC) 3 times, 3 SC, (3 SC, INC) 3 times [36].

**Round 6:** 3 SC, (2 SC, INC, 2 SC) 3 times, 3 SC, (2 SC, INC, 2 SC) 3 times [42].

**Round 7:** (3 SC, INC, 3 SC) 6 times [48].

**Round 8:** (7 SC, INC) 6 times [54].

**Rounds 9-20:** 12 rows SC [54 Stitches per row]

**Round 21:** (DEC, 7 SC) 6 times [48]

**Round 22:** (DEC, 6 SC) 6 times [42]

Start stuffing here. Stuff firmly.

**Round 23:** (DEC, 5 SC) 6 times [36]

**Round 24:** (DEC, 4 SC) 6 times [30]

**Round 25:** (DEC, 3 SC) 6 times [24]

**Round 26:** (DEC, 2 SC) 6 times [18]

**Round 27:** (DEC, 1 SC) 6 times [12]

**Round 28:** (DEC) 6 times [6]

FO leaving a long tail. Thread tail through last 6 stitches and pull up tight to close hole.

## SNOUT

In Fern, Ch 2

**Round 1:** 6 SC in 2<sup>nd</sup> CH from hook [6].

**Round 2:** INC in each stitch [12].

**Round 3:** INC BLO, SC in each stitch [12].

**Round 4:** SC row [12].

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing. Embroider two nostrils on the snout using straight stitches before sewing to the body making one nostril bigger than the other. Lightly stuff and sew to the main body.

## EARS (Make 2)

In Fern, Ch 2

**Round 1:** 4 SC in 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook [4].

**Round 2:** INC in each stitch [8].

**Rounds 3-4:** 2 rows SC [8 stitches per row].

**Round 5:** (DEC, 2 SC) 2 times [6].

**Round 6:** SC row [6].

**Round 7:** SC opening closed [3].

Fasten off. Embroider the inside of the ears in black before sewing to the top of the main body.

## EYES (make 2)

In White, Ch 4

**Round 1:** SC in 2<sup>nd</sup> Chain from hook, SC, 3 SC in last stitch, using the unused loops from the 1<sup>st</sup> three stitches, 2 SC, 3 SC in chain from first stitch [10].

**Round 2:** 2 SC, (INC) 3 times, 2 SC, (INC) 3 times [16].

Fasten off. Embroider pupils in black.

Sew to the main body above the snout.

Use the picture for placement.

Embroider Bruises in purple one on one eye and two on the other side. Using a straight stitch, embroider eyebrows over the eyes.

## TAIL

In Fern, Ch 16

**Row 1:** SC in 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook, 14 SC. [15].

Fasten off, Curl tail around finger and sew to back of pig.

## HELMET

In Graymist, Ch 5

Oval increase

**Round 1:** Starting in 2<sup>nd</sup> Chain from hook, 3 SC, 3 SC in last stitch, using the unused loops from the 1<sup>st</sup> three stitches, 3 SC, 3 SC in chain from first stitch [12].

**Round 2:** 3 SC, (INC) 3 times, 3 SC, (INC) 3 times [18].  
**Round 3:** 3 SC, (SC, INC) 3 times, 3 SC, (SC, INC) 3 times [24].  
**Round 4:** 3 SC, (SC, INC, SC) 3 times, 3 SC, (SC, INC, SC) 3 times [30].  
**Round 5:** 3 SC, (3 SC, INC) 3 times, 3 SC, (3 SC, INC) 3 times [36].  
**Round 6:** 3 SC, (2 SC, INC, 2 SC) 3 times, 3 SC, (2 SC, INC, 2 SC) 3 times [42].  
**Round 7:** 6 SC, INC, CH 18, Skip the next 14 stitches, (6 SC, INC) 3 times [].  
**Round 8:** 7 SC, INC, 18 SC in the chain, (7 SC, INC) 3 times [54].  
**Round 9:** (4 SC, INC, 4 SC) 6 times [60].  
**Round 10:** (9 SC, INC) 6 times [66].  
**Rounds 11-15:** 5 rows SC [66 stitches per row].  
**Round 16:** SC row in BLOs [66].  
Fasten off.  
Embroider cracks in Black.  
Sew to head.
